NEPTACON 2016 Abstract Submission

Introduction

The Scientific Committee of the NEPTACON 2016 invites for abstract submission for platform and poster presentations. The general submission guidelines are intended to provide clear instructions before submitting an abstract. You are kindly requested to carefully read the guidelines stated below.

The Scientific committee maintains the right to reject any abstract that does not meet below requirements or is in violation of them.

Please note that number of presentations is limited. Abstract submission will be closed early as soon as we reach our requirement. So please submit your abstracts early.

General Submission guidelines

1. The Scientific Committee encourages the submission of original scientific material before 7th September, 2016, submissions received after this deadline will not be considered.
2. All abstracts must be submitted via email "neptacon2016@gmail.com" to NEPTA, Nepal.
3. Multiple abstract will be encouraged
4. Non NEPTA member may also submit the abstract.
5. All content of the abstract must be the work of the author (s) of the abstract.
6. The Abstract must contain details of Presenter and the other authors including the full names, organization, email address, city/ country.
7. Complete Abstract documents are restricted to 3000 characters (including spaces, title, authors and institutions, cited references).
8. Abstract should not contain tables or graphs.
9. The acceptance and the selection of your abstract will be confirmed by email.
10. Case reports or case studies are also encouraged for submission.

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11. Abstract must be submitted under three categories (Please specify with details mentioning Name of the College and University along with “Date and Status of enrollment”)
 - a. Category A: BPT Students or equivalent
 - b. Category B: BPT graduates or equivalent and Post graduate students
 - c. Category C: MPT graduates or equivalent or above
12. The presenter must specify the mode of presentation. (Oral presentation or Poster presentation). The Scientific committee would have the final verdict on the mode of presentation.
13. Note: The outstanding presenter in each category and mode of presentation will be awarded at the end of the conference
14. Format of Abstract submission: the Abstract must in Microsoft word with the following headings:
 - a. Title of abstract: Mention category, interested mode of presentation
 - b. Names of presenter and co-authors with details
 - c. An abstract body [maximum 350 words]
 - Title of the study
 - Brief Background
 - Purpose/ Objective of the study
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion(s) (may include recommendations for future work)
 - Implication(s) of the study
 - Keywords: up to FIVE words
 - d. Funding
 - e. Conflict of interests
 - f. Ethical approval: please mention the Institution review board with ethical clearance number
 - g. Clinical trial registration- for Clinical trials

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Oral/ Platform Presentation

- The presentation must be done using Microsoft PowerPoint.
- Total Eight minutes will be provided for the presentation.
- Speaker will be notified about the time two minutes before the time ends.
- Two minutes will be allocated for the discussion and questions from the audiences.

Poster Presentation

- Posters are reports summarizing information using brief written statements and graphic materials, such as graphs, charts, figures and photographs mounted on a poster board, the dimensions of **6 feet X 4 feet**.
- Posters will be on display for one day during the conference time. Presenters will be given FIVE minutes time to present in front of the moderators
- TWO minutes of question and answer time after the presentation.
