

# **UPDATES ON DAMAGE DUE TO STORM IN BARA, PARSA**

*1 April 2019 (18 Chaitra 2075) Monday (As of 5:00 pm)*

**First Information Report:**

- **27** people died in southern Bara adjacent to Parsa
- Around 1044 people injured are receiving emergency services
- Security personnel have been deployed to the affected areas for rescue and relief operations (Source: National Emergency Operation Center)

**Key activities undertaken by HEOC, MOHP:**

- First Information received from NEOC (6:13 AM)
- Information communicated to: Dr Pushpa Chaudhary, Secretary, Dr Sushil Nath Pyakurel- Chief Specialist, Dr Guna Raj Lohani - DG, Dr Dipendra Raman Singh - Chief, Quality Standards Regulations, Chuda Mani Bhandari - Chief, HEDMU/HEOC (through viber), Mr Mahendra Shrestha - Chief, Health Coordination Division and Dr Bibek Kumar Lal - Chief, Epidemiology and Diseases Control Division and WHO Health Emergencies Programme, WHO.

- Incident Management System was activated at 7:30 AM at HEOC
- Information recording template sent to hospitals for line listing of dead and injured patients
- Kathmandu valley hub hospitals were alerted for emergency deployment of Emergency Medical Deployment Team (EMDT) and requested them (along with satellite hospitals) to be ready for casualties from Bara and Parsa.
- Field update communicated to National Emergency Operation Center (NEOC)
- MOHP requested activation of UNICEF for Emergency Nutrition and Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) immediately. Requested DG, DWSS for support from cluster lead as WASH.
- Hon State Minister of Health and Population chaired emergency high level coordination meeting at HEOC (10:00 am)

### **Team Deployment:**

- Hon Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Health and Population, State Minister for Health and Population, DG, Department of Health Services went to incident site to support the response coordination and response monitoring.
- Two Teams as follows deployed for response coordination, temporary EOC setup, epidemiological management and information management:
  - o Dr. Dr Ramesh Kumar Kharel, one team has been mobilized to the incident site from MoHP.
  - o Dr Dipendra Raman Singh, Dr Bibek Kumar Lal, Dr Madhab Kumar Lamsal, Dr Shrawan Kumar Mishra and Dr. Rajan Bikram Rayamajhi from WHO.
- Emergency Medical Deployment Team (EMDT) mobilized to support response.
  - o One team from Nepal Army
  - o Two teams from Nepal Police
  - o One team from Hetauda Hospital
  - o One team from Chitwan Medical College
  - o One team from Janakpur Zonal Hospital
- Nepal Ambulance Service (NAS) deployed ambulance at Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA) to respond the patients. It is facilitated by Dr Hemanta Chandra Ojha at TIA.
- Dr Pushpa Chaudhary, Health Secretary and Mr Mahendra Shrestha, Division Chief, MoHP visited TUTH for situation updates and monitoring of patients status.

#### **Key Action Points and Decisions:**

1. Establishment of Temporary Provincial Health Emergency Operation Center (PHEOC) at the hub hospital (Narayani Sub Regional Hospital) for information management and communication.
2. MOHP agreed to allocate additional budget for the establishment of PHEOC for Province 2.
3. Need to establishment of temporary health facilities at the affected sites and strengthening services of existing Health Posts (Bara - Kalaiya within 20 KM premises). NRCS District Chapters agreed to provide tents for setting up of temporary facilities.
4. It was also decided to request the coordination meeting of Emergency Nutrition and WASH for respective cluster interventions.
5. Teams to be deployed from Central Level MoHP, DoHS and WHO for information management, monitoring and coordination.
6. Rapid Health Assessment is ongoing by the Rapid Response Team and Teams from Central level.
7. Patients Line Listing along with trauma details needs to be updated for prompt deployment of surge support.
8. Emergency Medical Deployment Team (EMDT) to be mobilized at Hospitals and RRT to the community for response.
9. WHO Emergency District Support Officers (WEDS) to be mobilized to the affected site for necessary support

10. Health Sector Partners meeting planned for 11 am tomorrow at HEOC to review the current situation and response.
11. Hub networks to be alerted further by HEOC
12. Children's Hospital to be alerted for pediatrics casualties
13. Hospitals to provide key details on casualties using tools, instruments sent by HEOC.
14. Additional WEDS Officers to be mobilized to the field to strengthening communication, coordination and recording/reporting actions if necessary.
15. Additional Logistics (medical/surgical supplies, medical/surgical equipment) to be managed as per need.
16. Rapid Response Team in the field mobilized for community level communication/coordination
